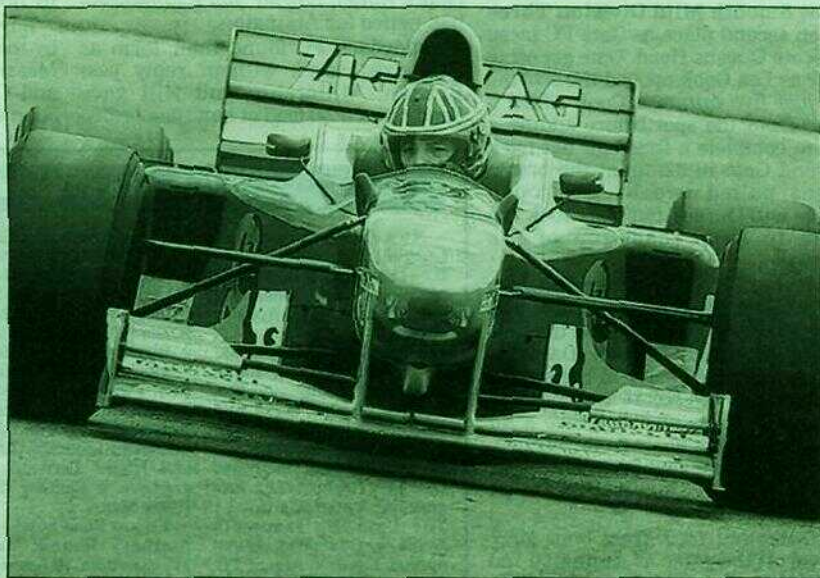


# Help needed to put Mansell on track

A YOUNG driving prodigy is appealing for help to make his Formula One dream come true.

Sixteen-year-old Scott Mansell already has the right name for motor racing success but he now needs the right car.

The teenager from Clifton Campville has been competing in the NDS EuroBOSS championship and is second in the British standings with two rounds to go.

However, his goal is to climb behind the wheel of a Formula One car next season to challenge for the

EuroBOSS title.
