

Mansell to race in a Formula One car

TAMWORTH schoolboy Scott Mansell will become the youngest ever British driver to compete in a Formula One car this Sunday.

The 17-year-old will compete in Jean Alesi's former 770bhp Bennetton at Donington in

rounds five and six of the EuroBOSS Championship.

Last season, Mansell became the youngest ever EuroBOSS competitor when he drove a 470bhp Reynard in the F3000 class.

Now Mansell, who is the *Herald* Sports Personality of the year, has graduated to the top flight and has broken Jenson Button's record for competing in such a powerful car, he was 20 when he was given his chance in Formula

One.

Admission is £10 per adult including admission to the paddock and grandstand areas while accompanied under-16s will be admitted free. Tickets will be available on the day.
