Scott Mansell and Klaas Zwart had the Donington Park crowd on their feet at round six of the EuroBOSS championship on Sunday.

Eighteen-year-old Mansell, who has recently received his A Level results from Bishop Vesey's Grammar School, qualified the 1997 Zig-Zag Benetton on pole but was beaten into the first corner by a brilliant move from Klaas Zwart

in his much improved Ascari Judd.

Scott said: "Qualifying went well, I believe it was one of the best laps I have put together around Donington even though the lap time was slower due to a slippery track.
