

Scott on track for title

Bishop Vesey School's rising star of the track Scott Mansell has continued his domination of the EuroBOSS series.

Driving Jean Alesi's 1996 F1 Benetton, the teenager won round four at Lansitz to preserve his 100 per cent record.

He won by three seconds, although his margin of victory would have been greater had it not been for the introduction of the pace car with a quarter of the race to go.

New lap record

But he sped off again from the pack to complete the win, setting a new lap record of 1:31.23mins in the process.

His lead at the top of the drivers' championship is now 27 points with the next round at Zolder in Belgium this weekend.

"Everything is going really well this season and we just have to keep it going," he said.
