

Super Scott's record run



Tamworth racer Scott Mansell is making mincemeat of lap records around Europe having been blistering in Belgium.

Driving his Zig-Zag Mansell Motorsport Benetton-Judd, once piloted by the mercurial Jean Alesi, he obliterated the established mark at the Zolder circuit.

The 18-year-old put in a lap of 1:19.73 in qualifying for the EuroBOSS event to go 2.4 seconds under the record. And his fully fuelled car lapped in

1:20.07 during the race - making it five outright track records set in a row in a sparkling season so far for the Clifton Campville speed merchant.

But he was forced into retirement after an electrical fault and the race was won by his closest title rival, Klass Zwart, whom he now leads by 19 points with three races to go. The next round of the EuroBOSS championship is at Donington Park on August 29.
